Abstract: A method for suggesting transliteration for user inputs, comprising: receiving an original user input composed of alpha-numeric characters; identifying the possibility of transliterating the input; determining at least one potential transliteration by performing at least one of the following replacing a sequence of characters in the original input to a possible sequence of Arabic characters) determining the probabilities of the potential transliterated alternatives to the user input; and electing the most likely transliteration according to some predetermined criteria verifying the suggested output against a validation repository, the validation repository having a large corpus of Arabic words.
